Oregon Woodcarver's Rendezvous Set for September

The Oregon woodcarving rendezvous is again scheduled for Thursday, September 13 thru Sunday, September 16 at Canyonview Camp in Silverton. Classes start at noon on Thursday and run thru noon on Sunday. Sessions are 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM.The Fall Rendezvous will be held at Canyonview Camp (3 miles south of Silverton). There will be multiple-session class periods per day. Some of the classes being discussed are Butternut duck, Kachina Eagle Dancer, Mesa Verde in cottonwood, Janet Clemen Snowman. Other sessions include chip carving, caricature carvings, and wood burning.
