"BORED" DINNER AND BREAKFAST



Capital Woodcarvers Carving Show Rules

Rules for awards at Capital Woodcarvers show, Salem, Oregon, April 2-3, 2011.

- 1. Carvings must be no more than two (2) years old and not have won a ribbon in a previous Capital Woodcarvers Show.
- 2. One entry per registrant in the proper show category. See number 4 below.
- 3. Entrant Categories

A. Youth: Must be less than 18 years of age

B. Beginner: Must have carved less than three (3) years.

C. Intermediate: Must have carved for more than three (3) years and less

than five (5) years.

D. Advanced: Must have carved for more than five (5) years.

- 4. Only one (1) carving in each of the applicable categories. Again, all carvings must also qualify with the first two rules.
- 5. Show categories

a. Intarsia

- b. Relief
- c. Woodburning
- d.. Fantasies/Caricatures/Whimsical
- e. Wild Life/Waterfowl
- g. Open

Club awards made during the show:

- a. First, second and third place in each entrant and show category.
- b. Best of show or People's Choice. This is voted upon separately from and may come from any entrant or show categories.
- e. Carvers Choice is voted upon by the registered carvers and may come from any of the entrant or show categories.
- d. Designated awards as the show committee sees fit, such as the Center 50+ Directors Award, Audubon Award, Duck Unlimited and/or Carousel Directors Award. These awards may come from anywhere on the floor.
- e. Burt Henry Award. This is judged by a committee selected by the show chairman. The Award is to come from the entrant and show categories.
